CAMPsites: Each campsite can accommodate between 30-40 campers (15 tents x 2 or 3 campers per tent). **The BSA policy is that no youth is permitted to sleep in the tent of an adult other than his own parent or guardian.** This policy may affect the ratio of youth to adults each campsite can accommodate.

PLEASE INDICATE YOUR 1st (1) and 2nd (2) CHOICE. *Campsite name does NOT indicate the activity pins Scouts will work on while at camp.* Scouts have an opportunity to work on all activity pins offered no matter which campsite they occupy.

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION THOROUGHLY BEFORE SUBMITTING.

Early bird camp fee for 2018 is \$170 per camper if paid in full by May 1. May 2 and after, regular pricing of \$205 per camper goes into effect. A non-refundable deposit of \$50 per person is due with this form. Deposits may be transferred to replacement campers not previously registered.

Once your form and deposits are received at the Council, you will be sent an e-mail with login information. You will have online access to your reservation with the ability to enter names and make payments towards your balance.

Refer to the site reservation chart on the Council's website for session/site availability prior to submitting your reservation. Availability changes daily. Contact Shannon at the Center for Scouting at (920) 734-5705 for availability.

Minimum leadership requirements for a Unit is a ratio of 1 adult for every 4 youth attending but **TWO-DEEP leadership is required for a Unit to attend camp.** **If a female Scout is attending, one female adult must be part of your two-deep leadership.** Youth and adults will be housed in separate wall tents on wooden platforms. All food will be provided.

Total camp fees are due by May 1, 2018. Unpaid balances after May 1, 2018, will result in a \$35 per-person late charge. If your Pack makes a reservation after May 1st, you must pay your camp fee in full at the time of your reservation.

Make all reservations, payments, changes, and roster updates through **one** registered adult from your Pack. This person will be the designated contact with access to your reservation online. He or she can review invoices and submit payments, and access/enter the roster. *Roster changes (if changing a gender or registrant type) will be accepted by written request only and must be approved by the Council.*

NOTE: A **ONE WEEK** grace period will be given for any verbally approved reservation. After 1 week, if deposit and registration form are not received at the Center for Scouting, the site will be made available to other groups (without notice) and the "penciled in" reservation will be automatically forfeited.
