What Campers Should Bring

Complete Cub Scout Uniform Two Pairs Hiking Shoes or Sneakers

Socks **Swimming Suit**

Underwear Sweatshirt or Jacket

T-shirts **Pajamas**

Backpack, Duffel Bag or Suitcase **Shorts** Flashlights and Extra Batteries Raincoat or Poncho

Camera Garbage Bag for Wet/Dirty Clothes Fishing Pole and Tackle Clothes Line Bible or Other Religious Book Water Bottle (marked with Scout's name) Pocketknife Sleeping
