#### Program Snapshot

When you think of summer camp, you think of swimming and hiking, right? Well we offer more than just your basic activities. Your 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders will experience 3 jam-packed days of fun and adventure. In the morning they will participate in skill building sessions such as first aid training, advanced swim skills, or wilderness survival. Come the afternoon, they'll experience many exciting activities such as rock climbing, archery, and a mountain biking trip!

#### Accommodations

Wall tents are provided for all of our campers, but you're welcome to bring your own tent if that'd make you feel more comfortable. Each campsite features a latrine (pit toilet) with a hand washing and water bottle filling station, a fire ring, and plenty of seating and shade from the sun. There is access to a nice shower facility just a few steps from each campsite and there are flush toilets available on the program side of the property.

#### Food Service

We are lucky to have plenty of room to serve everyone at camp, even with COVID precautions. We have a brand new dining hall available as well as a large event tent that provides shelter and a nice breeze for those hot summer days. Our kitchen staff are Serv-Safe certified and our kitchen is managed by CORD Incorporated. If you do have any dietary needs, please visit the Documents and Forms section and let us know how we can help. Our kitchen is set up to avoid cross contamination while cooking.

#### Trading Post

While your son or daughter is at camp, they'll have an opportunity to check out the camp store, also known as the Trading Post. There's plenty of healthy snacks, candy, trinkets, wilderness tools,

Buddy/Truddy is used to describe groups of 2 or 3 that we encourage youth to move through camp in. Webelos is a Scouting term used when referring to 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Leave No Trace is an eco-friendly training we encourage the use of at camp. It's most likely to be heard when referring to picking up trash and making sure we have our recycling in the right place.
